

PLASTIC HOUSING WITH 4 MOUNTING HOLES BOLT M5X127 WITH LOCK NUTS

FEED RESTRICTOR

FULLY ASSEMBLED FEEDER SHOWN ON PAGE 2

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Insert plastic feed activator into the top of the plastic housing and lower it down until it begins to protrude through the bottom hole of the housing, as shown in **Figure #1**.

Note: It is very important that the feed activator be installed correctly in order for feeder to work properly.

2. Slide the stainless protector bracket onto bottom of the plastic housing as shown in **Figure #2**.

Ensure that the holes in the bracket align with the holes in the housing.

3. Attach stainless protector bracket to the plastic housing using two of the bolt M5X12 with lock nuts, and one bolt M5X127 with lock nut.

Depending on how much feed you want released, there are three possible configurations/settings for the M5X127 bolt with lock nut - HIGH, MEDIUM AND LOW, as shown in **Figure #3**.




Note: Step #4 is optional. 4.


If you are using pellets or a coarse feed, the feed restrictor may not be necessary. Should you wish to install the feed restrictor, insert


it into the plastic housing from the top, as shown in Figure #4.

Continue to gently lower it down until it rests on the plastic feed activator you installed in Step #1.

5. Note: Step #5 is optional.

An extension to the ad lib feeder is also available. (Part # i-10105ext-HDW) To install extension, simply set it inside the ad-lib feeder as shown in Figure #5 and use the 3 screws that are provided with it to fasten the hopper to the plastic housing.
