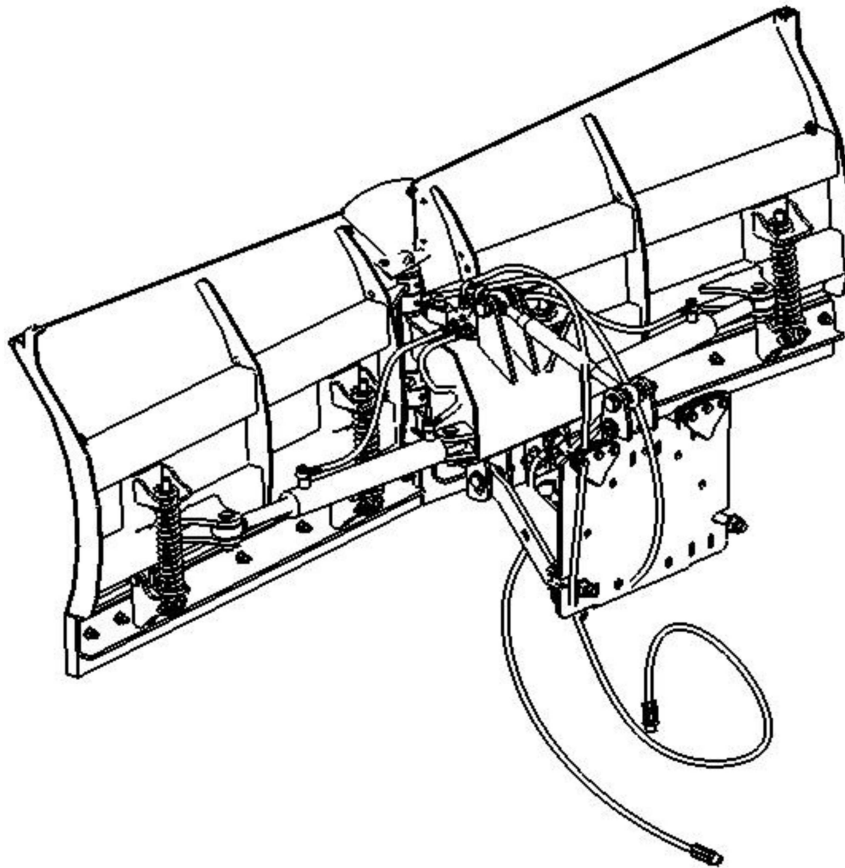

Before operation

DANGER !

- ★ Make sure that the snow shovel and the car (other) connecting frame have been connected.
- ★ Operate in a safe area.
- ★ Ensure that the snow shovel is installed firmly.
- ★ Ensure that all hydraulic joints and hydraulic devices are firmly connected.
- ★ Replace vulnerable devices and hoses.
- ★ Determine the power supply voltage. If the voltage is less than the required voltage, it will affect the performance of the snow shovel.
- ★ If people or objects are loaded on the working machine, it will cause injury accidents after falling. Do not carry people or anything on the working machine.

During operation

DANGER !

- ★ Press the button on the remote control before starting to remove snow. Place the snow shovel at an appropriate angle.
- ★ Use the up and down buttons of the remote control to adjust the snow shovel to be parallel to the road surface.
- ★ After adjusting the up and down and angle of the snow shovel, you can start the vehicle to move forward and perform snow removal operations.
- ★ When walking on the slope at high speed, it may cause side slip or rollover. Please downshift and slow down before entering the slope and cross the slope smoothly.
- ★ Be sure to concentrate and drive carefully when working.
- ★ If someone approaches when lifting the shovel, it may cause injury. Please stay away.
- ★ When making machine adjustments and removing debris, be sure to cut off the engine. Otherwise, due to the carelessness of a third party, the work machine suddenly starts, which may cause unexpected things to happen.
- ★ After the snow removal operation is completed, the shovel must be lifted up and allowed to enter to avoid damage to the road surface.

After operation

- ★ After the machine is used, the shovel body and joints should be cleaned with a high-pressure water gun.
- ★ Grease the exposed cylinder rod
- ★ Thoroughly remove all dirt, dirt and grease on the clean surface.
- ★ The interfaces of hydraulic oil pipes, cylinders and battery valves are capped and sealed
- ★ Check the connecting bolts and tighten all loose bolts and nuts.
- ★ Fill all lubrication points with butter.
- ★ Replace damaged or obscure identification labels.

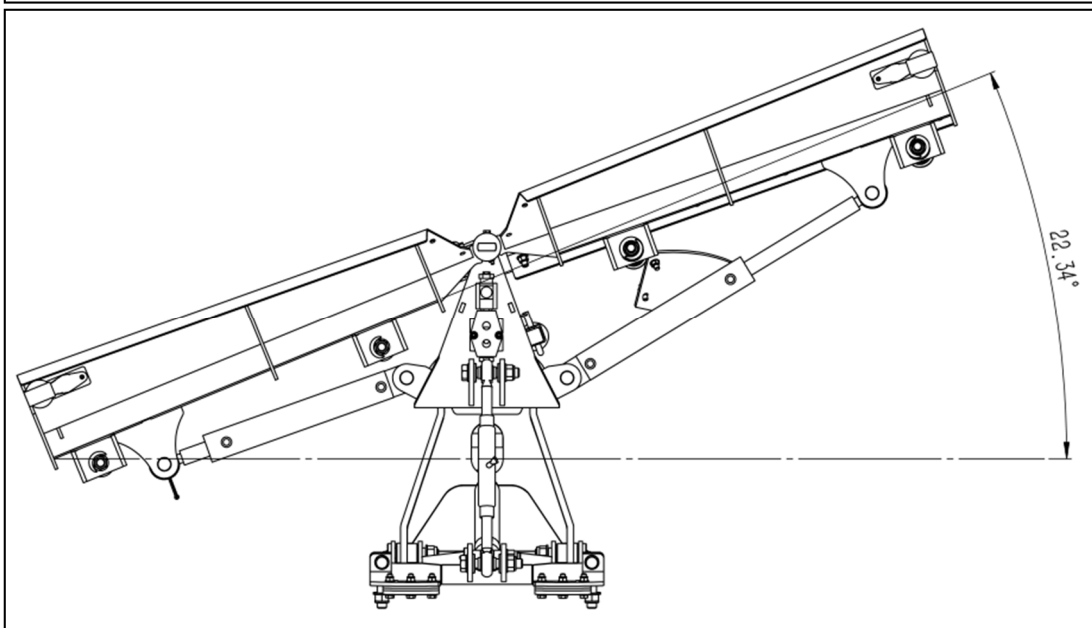
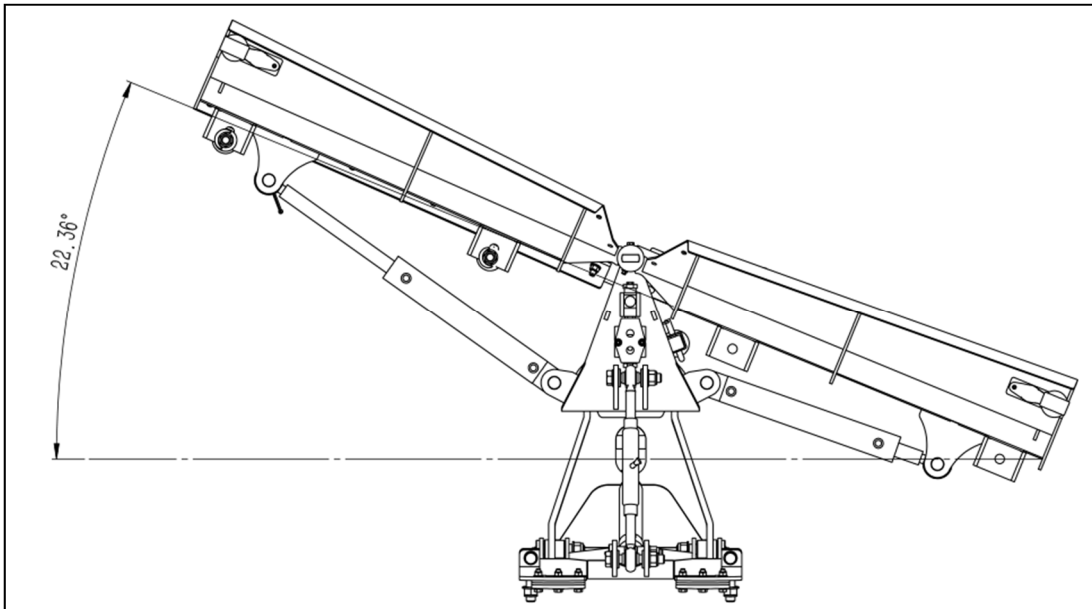
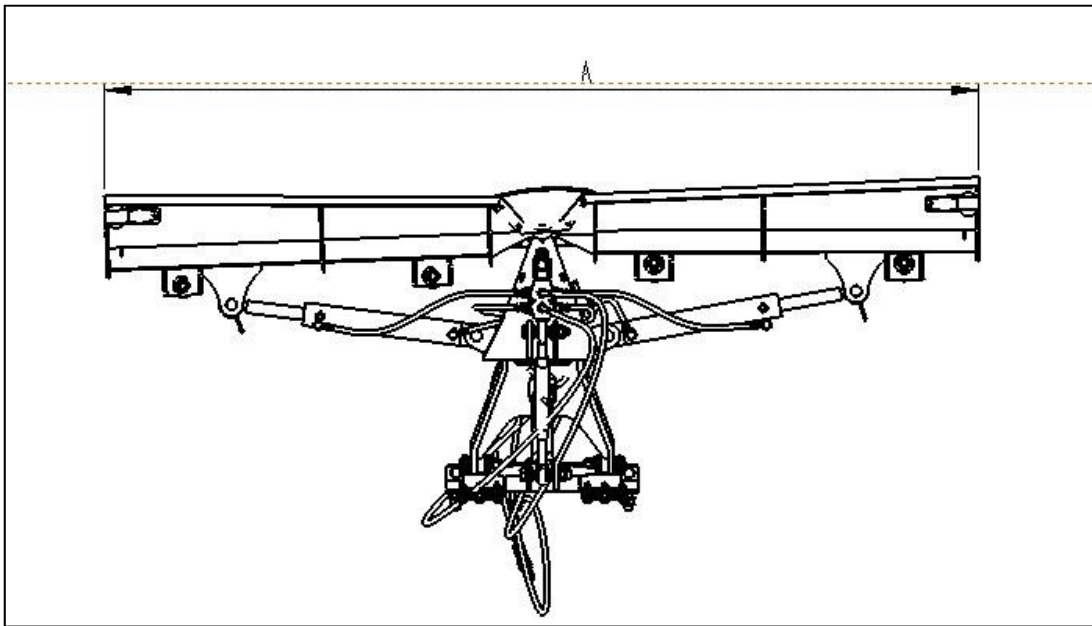
- ★ The snow shovel must be cleaned up before storage to prevent rainwater and hemolytic agent from corroding the shovel body.
- ★ In storage, the support frame of the snow shovel must be lowered, and the jack must be placed at the lowest level.
- ★ Cover the electrical parts with rain-proof cloth to prevent aging due to exposure to the sun.

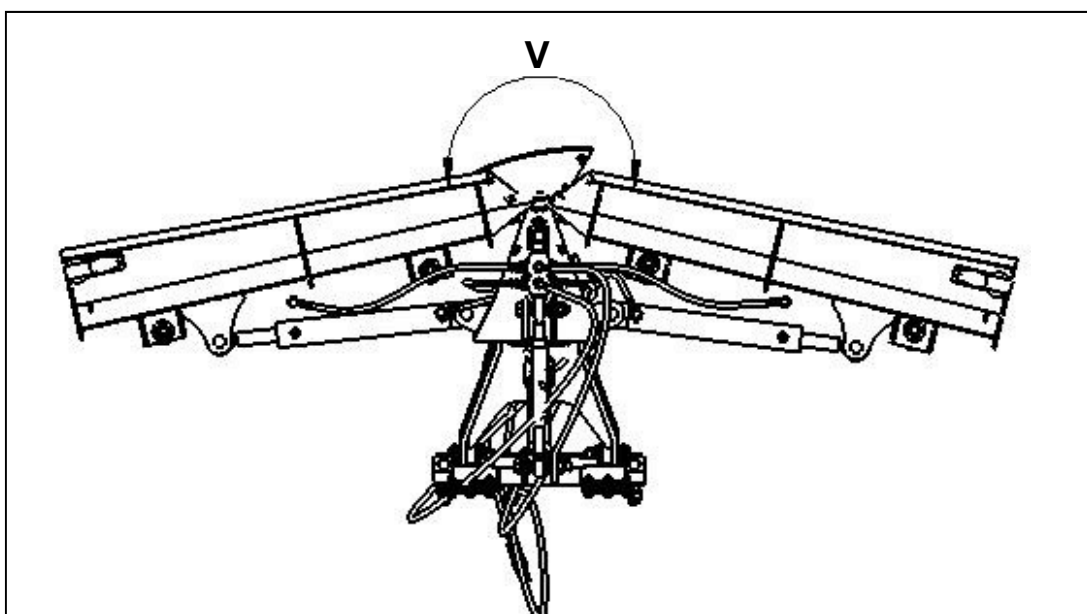
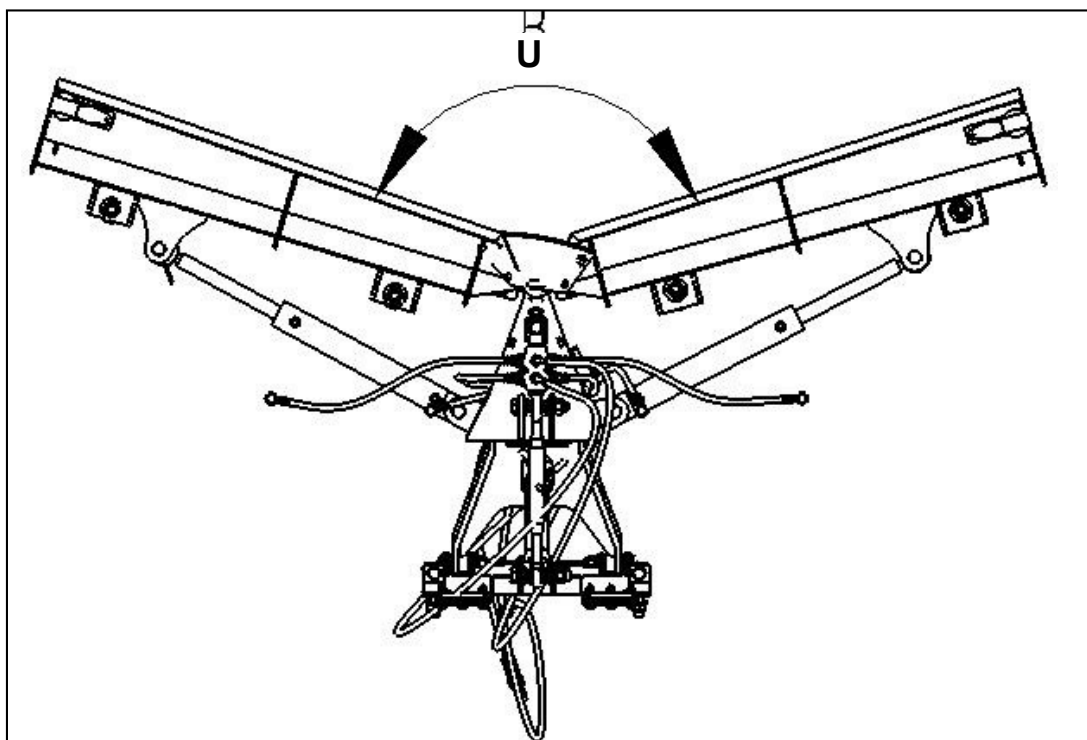

2. Assembly of bracket and shovel



Installation steps: align the right main shovel(3), bracket(1), and left main shovel (4) in sequence and align them with the king pin shaft welded parts (A6), then adjust the hole position at the end of the king pin shaft to be perpendicular to the bracket, Then use M8*70 bolts (A7) to insert and fasten.

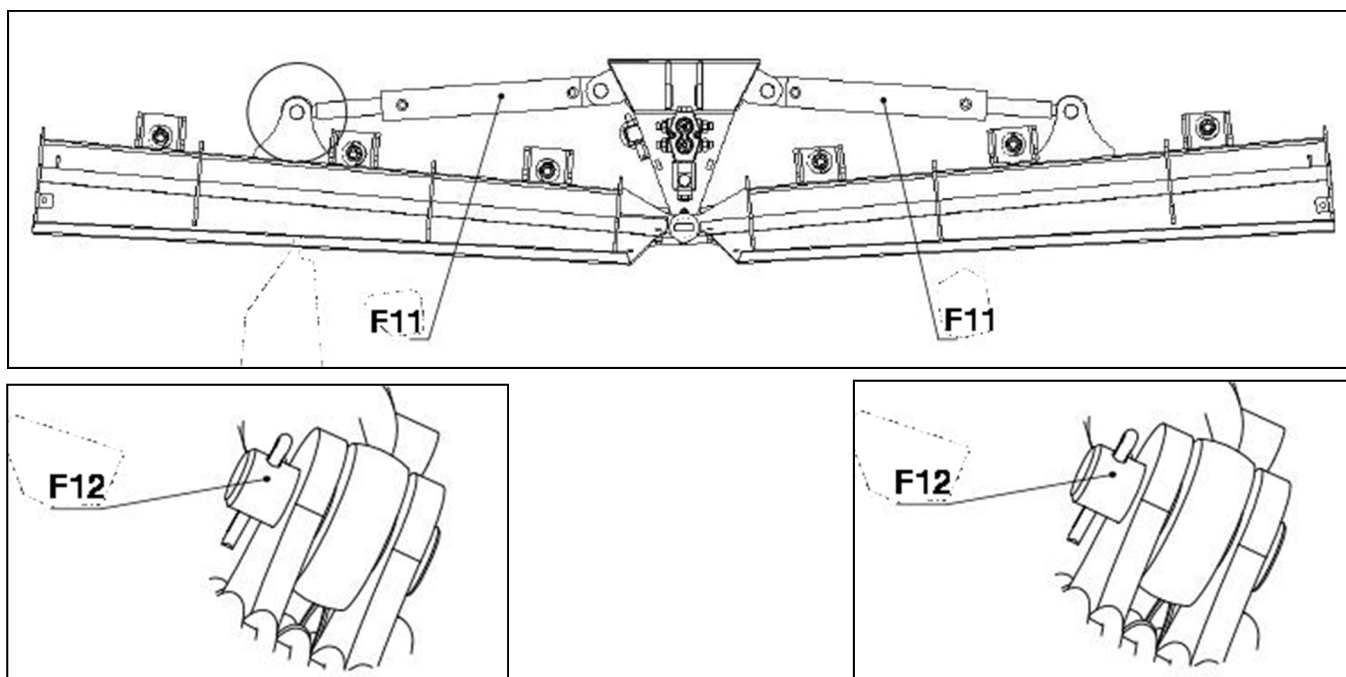

3. Installation of shovel cylinder



Installation steps: After installing the bracket, install the shovel cylinder(F11) according to the cylinder position in the above figure, and fix it with the cylinder pin(F12) and the split pin.

Note: The oil port of the oil cylinder is facing upwards, and the position of the cotter pin of the oil cylinder pin is facing downwards.

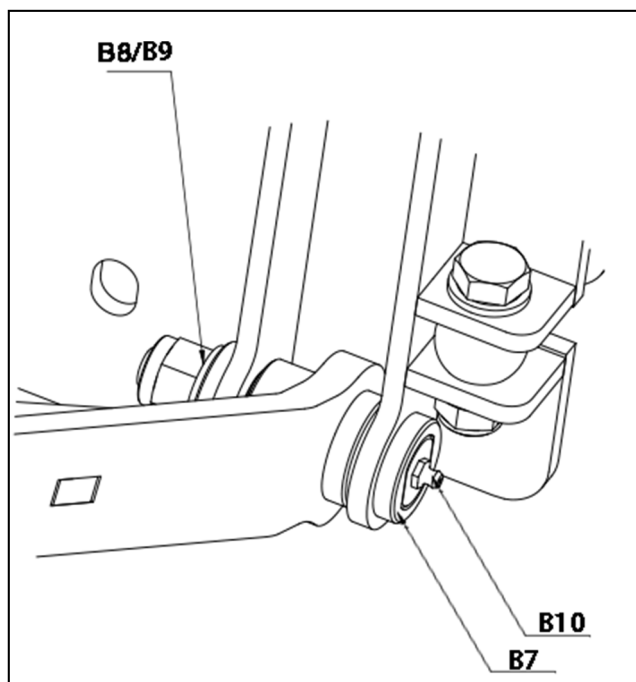
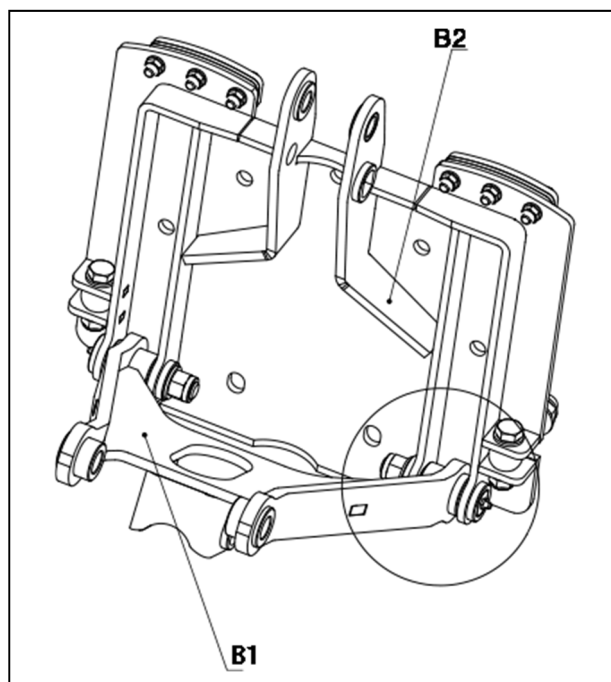

4. Installation of bracket component



Installation steps: 1. Align the mounting holes on the B1 and B2 pieces according to the style of the above figure, and then fix them with a pin with a flat washer and a lock nut.

Note: Do not reverse the direction of the lower bracket assembly.

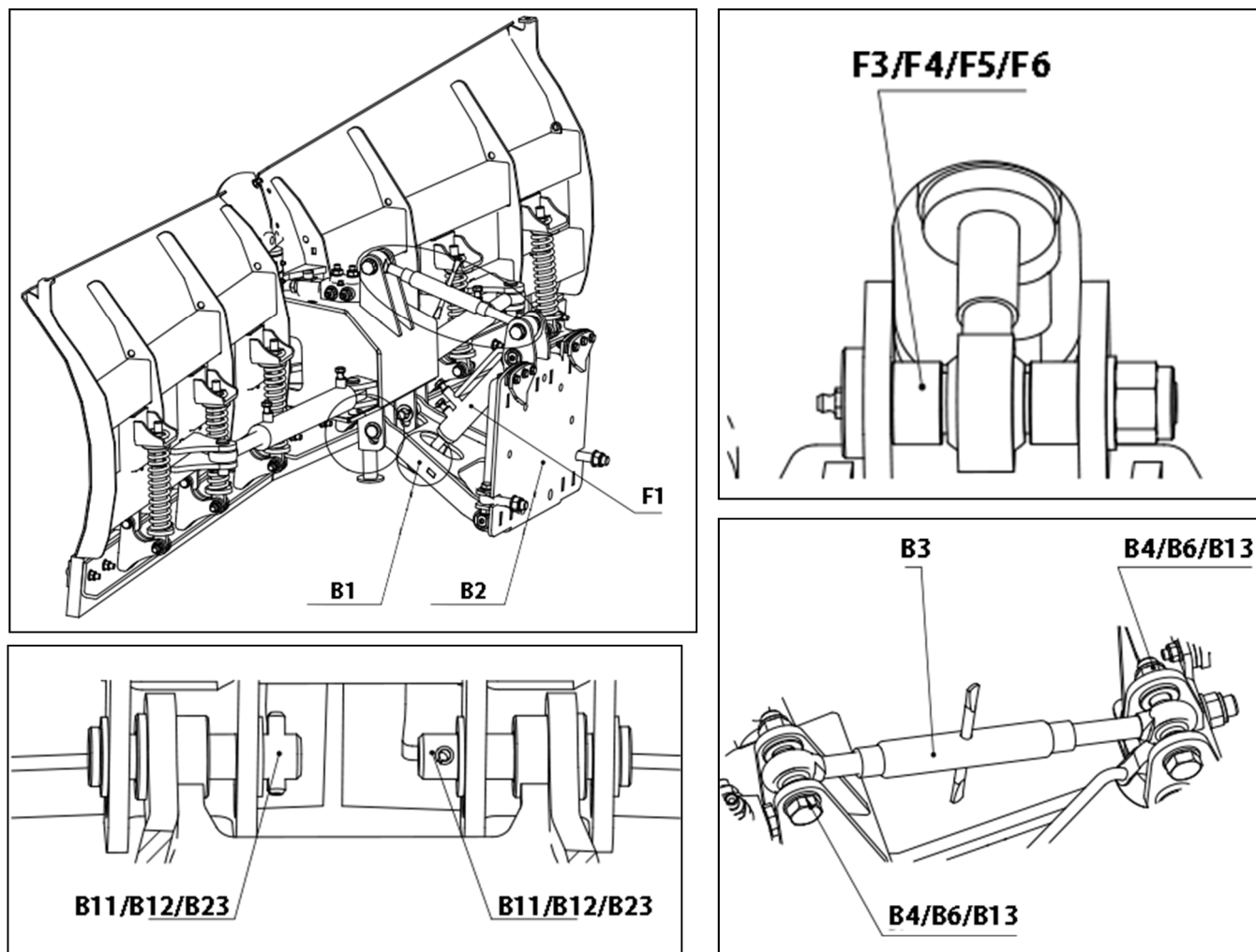

5. Installation of bracket assembly and bracket



Installation steps:

1. First align the Lower bracket welded parts (B1) with the hole on the Bracket Assembly (1) according to the style of the above figure, and then fix the cylindrical pin (B11) with the spring-type straight pin (B12) .
2. Installing the lifting cylinder (F1), first connect the connecting end with the lower bracket (B1), and install the other end after adjusting the angle of the bracket
Note: when connecting the cylinder, you need to add two gaskets as shown in the figure.
3. First adjust the length of the tie rod assembly (B3), so that the length can be matched with the bracket and bracket, and then use M20*120 bolts (B13) to insert and tighten the nuts(B6).

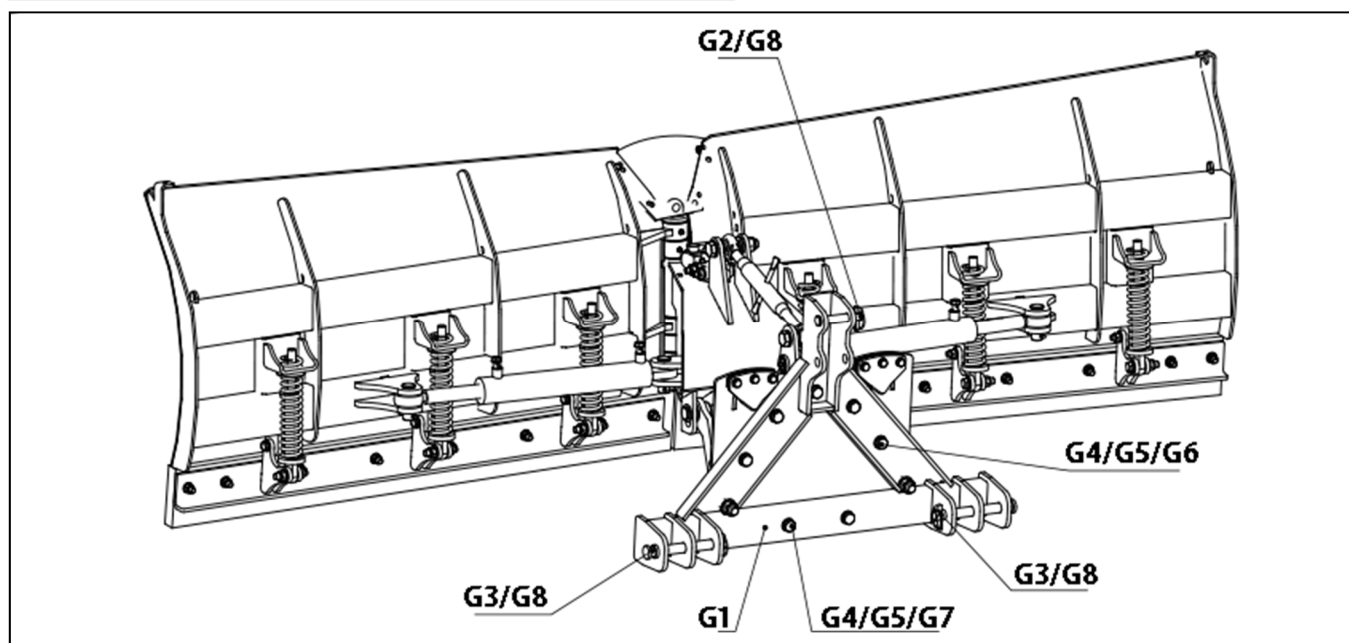
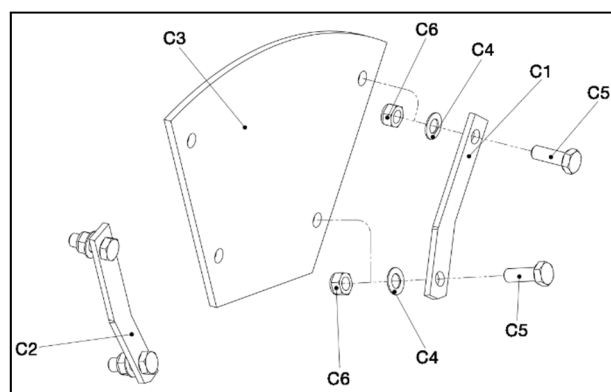
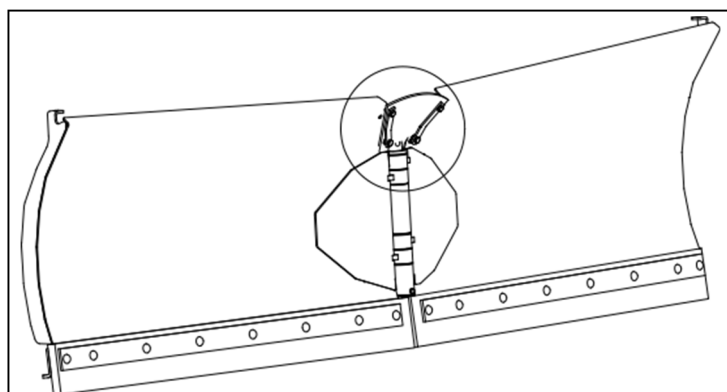

6. Installation of rubber components and three-point suspension



Installation steps:

1. Assemble the eraser in the order of the style above.
2. Install the three-point suspension according to the above figure with M16*50 bolts (G6) and flat washers (G4) and nuts (G5) to tighten, and finally fit the lock pin (G8) to insert the suspension connecting pin (G3) and the upper suspension pin (G2).

7. Cylinder and oil pipe connection

Installation steps:

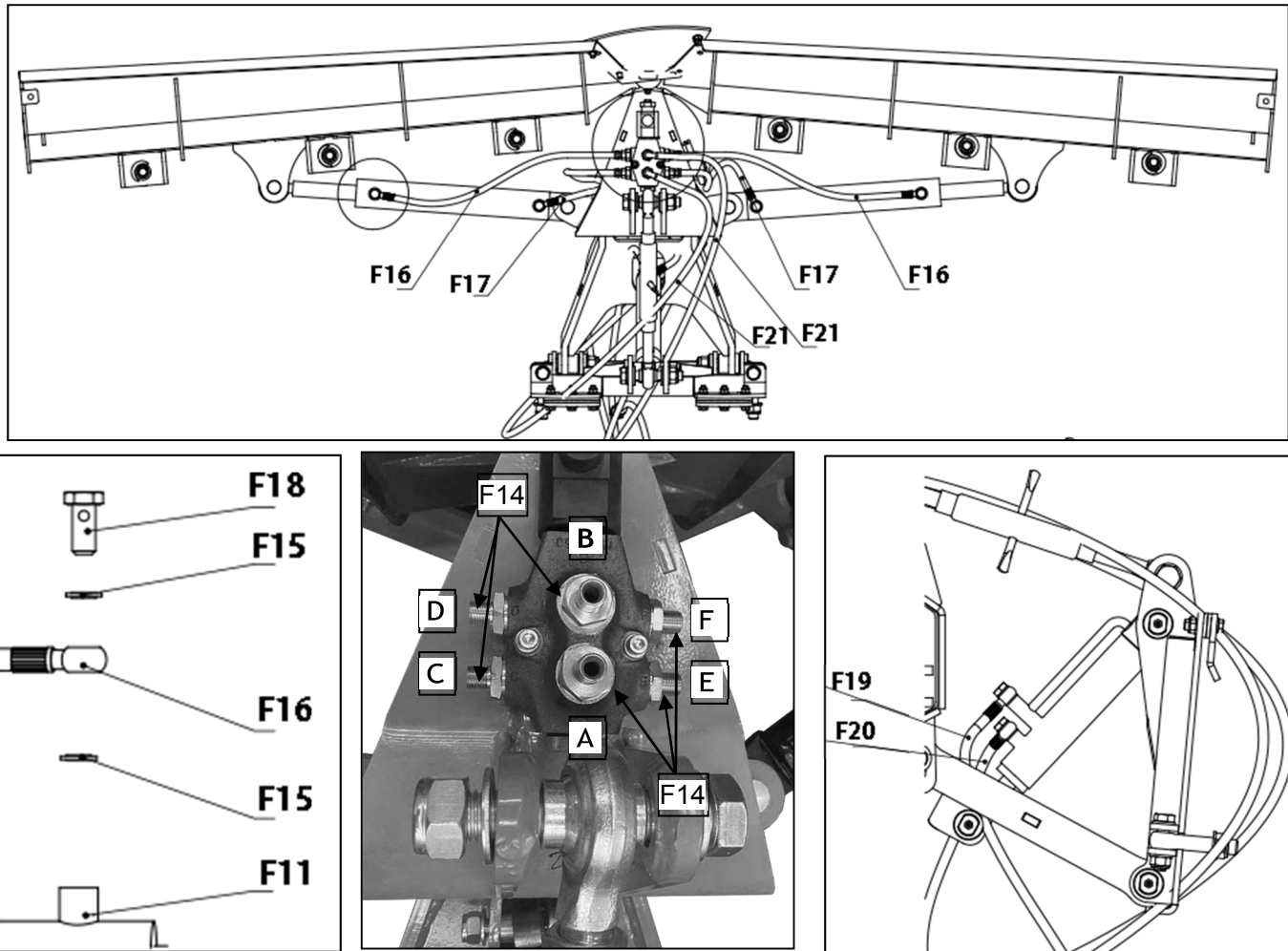
1. Firstly fasten the transition joints (F14) to the 6 ports of the solenoid valve.
2. Connect the left shovel cylinder with hollow bolts (F18) and combination washers (F15) to the hydraulic hose (F16,F17) to connect the solenoid valve **D** and **C** ends, and the right shovel cylinder with hollow bolts (F18) and combination washers (F15) to connect the hydraulic hose (F16,F17) to the solenoid valve **F** and **E** ports. The **A** and **B** ends of the solenoid valve are connected to the hydraulic hose (F21) (the other end of the oil pipe is connected to the tractor oil pump)
3. The lifting oil cylinder is connected to the hydraulic hose (F19, F20) respectively with the hollow bolt and the combined washer (the other end of the oil pipe is connected to the tractor

oil pump).
